We all had an amazing lunch thanks to Latisha and Mat.


We even had enough energy to whip around the tracks.

And what were they working on...? Introducing our new trail;






Make your way up to jungle junction head down tiggers tail and out on to ridge line follow the daynigher markers. The track begins on the left just before you head from the cutover back into the forest.

A high end grade 3 with some jumps-drops . A small section of tight corners and narrow steep downhill.

This track takes you to the start of Humpty Dumpty.

There is still work to do on the steep downhill, please take care through this section.
